PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE




Dear Dallas Ski Club Members:

Danube River Cruise

Fabulous is the description of this trip!!! We had a group of 31 fun loving people that were ready for adventure. We flew out of DFW with a stop in Amsterdam; then on to Budapest, Hungary. We spent 3 wonderful days touring the intriguing and unique city. We stayed at the Budapest Hilton, which was fabulous and highly recommended. On the 2nd night we had a wonderful welcome reception that was held in the hotel's outdoor patio with scrumptious appetizers and beverages. The weather was perfect. As a matter of fact, in 14 days, the weather in the afternoon was sunny and between 68 and 72 degrees for 11 of those days. It only rained some of the 3 other days, and that never stopped us. We missed all the rain and flooding in Texas, but when we got back . . . still more rain.

Everyone planned their own time in Budapest, but I think the highlights were the view of the Parliament at night, Fisherman's Bastion (which looked like a maze of sand castles) and St. Stephen's Basilica. Quite a few of us bought tickets for the Hop On and Hop Off Bus and toured the city. That way we could stay as long in any one place as we wanted to and hop back on the bus. We found that Budapest is one of the neatest and cleanest cities and a definite for anyone traveling that way.

After 3 wonderful days in Budapest, we boarded Luftner's Amadeus Elegant for a 7-day cruise down the Danube River. There were 150 people on the boat, which made it so much more intimate and cozy than a big cruise liner. We ate all 3 meals on the boat most days in between all the excursions in different quaint cities. We stopped and toured Esztergom, Bratislavia, Vienna, Duerstein, Melk, Linz, Regensburg and finally Passau, Germany. So we were in 4 countries (Hungary, Slavakia, Austria and Germany) during the cruise. And while on the cruise, there was live music and some local entertainment each evening. Of course the Dallas Ski Club group livened up the room by dancing around the room and a couple of people even did a pole dance (George Kelly and Betty Graham . . . but shhhhh, they wouldn't want that publicized). And another evening was Pirates night. Lynn Erickson, Betty Graham, Nancy and Ray Farrar came up with some pretty creative headwear.

Old Town, Prague Castle and the Charles Bridge were a must. From the Charles Bridge, the view of the city, sky lines and towers was magnificent. There were lots of vendors on the bridge where you could buy artwork, handmade jewelry and crafts done by local artisans. Hop On and Hop Off Bus was again another fun way to see the city in a leisurely way. We loved the food and especially the wines on the trip since they didn't have sulfates added (so smooth and no headaches the next day).

We all arrived home with luggage, no delays and lots of memories to share. Since we had so many memories and photos to share, Lynn Erickson hosted an after party at her fabulous home a couple of weeks later . . . and so more fun and laughs. 









