





Big Sky, MT Ski Trip | March 18-25

The Dallas Ski Club's Big Sky, Montana adventure was March 18-25, 2017. Big Sky is known for the "biggest skiing in America", and we stayed at the Summit Hotel which is located slope-side in Mountain Village and included a fabulous breakfast buffet each morning for our group. Our trip leader Judy ZumBerge lead a fun group of 36 which skied together in groups at all levels. Spring skiing was an amazing experience on the runs that told it like it was: Wounded Knee, Runaway, Bad Boy and Calamity Jane.
