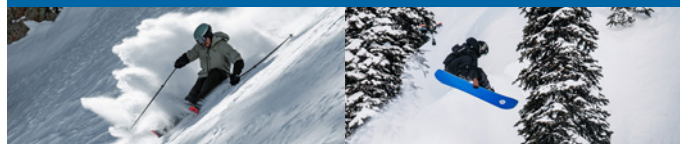

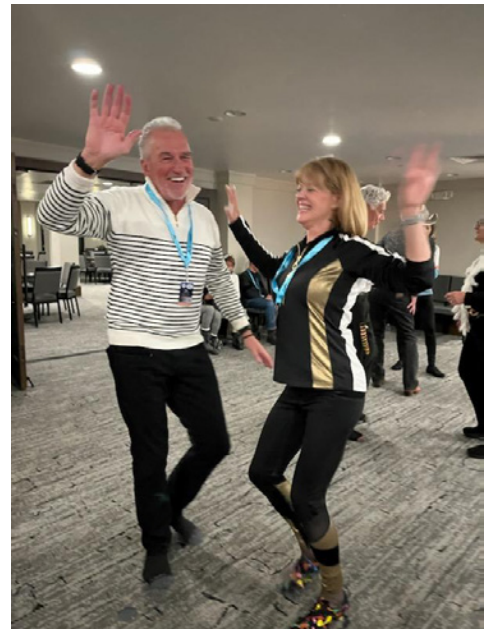

# Total Solar Eclipse

## April 8, 2024

Join us for this 'once in a lifetime' event on Monday, April 8th!! We'll meet around 12:20 pm at the White Rock Masonic Lodge No. 234, 15405 Addison Rd., Addison 75001, which is southeast of the Addison Airport - plenty of open space for great viewing!

The solar eclipse in Dallas will begin at 12:23 pm. The maximum point of the eclipse, when the moon completely covers the sun, will occur at 1:42 pm. The total duration of the eclipse will be approximately 2 hours and 39 minutes, with the totality phase lasting for 3 minutes and 52 seconds. During this remarkable event, the moon's shadow will sweep across the Earth, creating a captivating celestial display.

**Here are the key timings for the eclipse in Dallas (these times may change slightly):**

**Partial eclipse begins:** At 12:23:18 pm, when the edge of the Moon touches the edge of the Sun.

**Totality begins:** At 1:40:43 pm, when the edge of the Moon covers all of the Sun.  
**Maximum eclipse:** At 1:42:39 pm, the deepest point of the eclipse with the Sun at its most hidden.

**Totality ends:** At 1:44:35 pm, when the edge of the Moon exposes the Sun.  
***The total solar eclipse in Dallas will last for approximately 4 minutes and 28 seconds.***

During this awe-inspiring event, the moon will completely cover the sun, casting a shadow over the Earth and creating a breathtaking celestial spectacle!

We'll be meeting at the White Rock Masonic Lodge, which is just southeast of the Addison Airport where there's plenty of open space! The Lodge is north of Arapaho Rd & Addison Rd. Expect the Addison area to be very busy during this time. RSVP now!

Bring your lunch & your drink of choice! We'll have water bottles available as well as SOLAR WATCHING GLASSES to protect your eyes! No Cost!

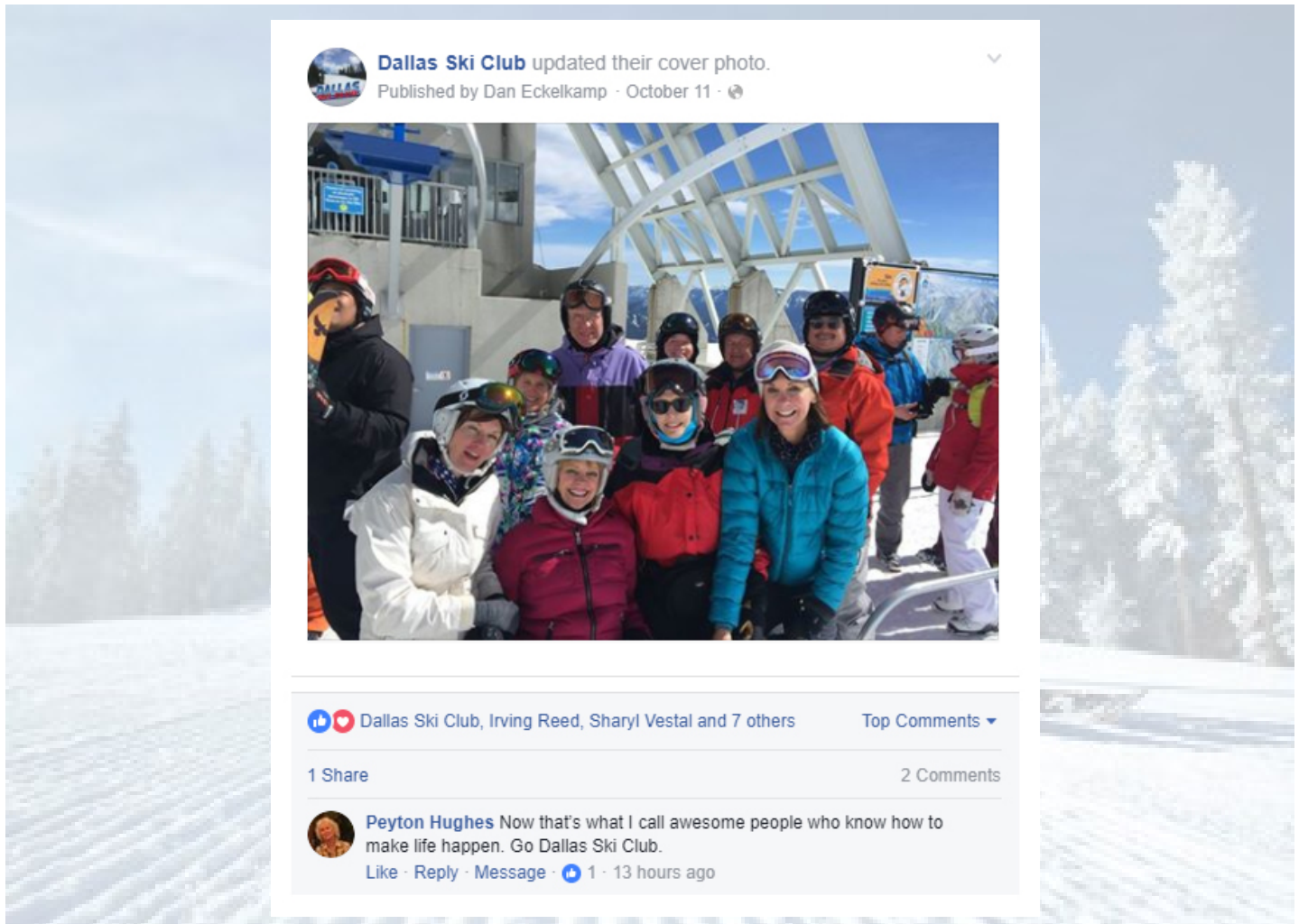
